Area Forum Update

The Lower Valley Area Forum meeting was held on Tuesday 9th September at the Hipperholme and Lightcliffe High School

The agenda of the meeting was developed from some of the issues which people raised at the Area Conference in July. These included issues around

- Public Transport,
- Facilities for Young People
- Anti Social behaviour etc
- Updates on Police/PSCO patrols.

The chair of the Area Forum Cllr Joyce Cawthra, said that all the issues which had been raised at the Area Forum Conference had been collated and included in a Tasking Plan, work is now being undertaken on the Tasking plan with various Council Departments and other Partner Agencies, such as the Primary Care Trust, Pennine Housing, West Yorkshire Police etc, and feedback will be provided at the next meeting of this Forum.

Calderdale CMBC Projects and Asset Manager provided an update on the Brighouse Swimming Pool and the Brighouse Civic Hall.

A Representative from the West Yorkshire Passenger Transport Executive attended the Area Forum to provide an overview of Public Transport provision, and the role of WYPTE.

Issues discussed included the:-

- Brighouse Bus Station
- Norwood Green bus provision
- Bus services in the Rastrick Area
- Safety of Young People and the Elderly using public transport.

Calderdale Councils Young Peoples Services Manager and a representative from the Youth Offending Team attended the Forum to give an overview of the provision and service provided in an educational role, supporting and enabling Young People through youth centres and Schools, working alongside other partner agencies to address anti social behaviour etc.



The Police Neighbourhood Team attended the Forum to provide an update on the concerns expressed by residents on the lack of visibility of Police/PSCO and foot patrols in the area.

It was confirmed that the area was split into a response team and neighbourhood team servicing the area by car and foot patrols.

The Principal Planning Officer gave a presentation to the Forum relating to the process for the development of the Local Development Framework, including the Core Strategy and Site Specific Allocations.

The final part of the meeting was an open forum, this provided an opportunity for residents to raise concerns that had not been covered on the agenda or resolved by officers prior to the meeting.

A number of residents raised issues regarding parking, traffic congestion around Stoney Lane and Safer Routes to School. Members assured residents that the views of residents will be taken on board.
