## Modules

You can choose any combination of the following modules according to your development needs.

Core modules

- **policy and partnership**
- **multi-professional teams**
- **safeguarding**
- **commissioning for change**

We also offer tailored modules that recognise your professional learning and projects that you can undertake in your workplace.

The teaching of each core module takes the equivalent of four days and can be delivered on campus or in your locality for groups of ten.

## Assessment

Assessments focus on evaluating or developing practice in your context.

These include

- written assignments
- presentations
- case studies
- investigations
- work-based projects

## Location

The course is based at City Campus, three minutes walk from the train station.

## Entry requirements

Normally a UK degree (or equivalent) plus relevant work experience

We also encourage applications from non-graduates with significant professional experience.

## Attendance

### Part-time

Typically one year to certificate, two years to diploma, three years to masters. Maximum six years.

## Fees

### Home and EU

Typically £1,200 to PgCert, £2,400 to PgDip, £3,600 to MA.

If you have Qualified Teacher Status, you are eligible for a discount. Fees are typically £850 to PgCert, £1,700 to PgDip, £2,550 to MA.
