Four of the Street Angels had an excellent afternoon at the Fire Station along with Ambassadors. The afternoon covered fire safety, the importance of following fire alarms evacuations, danger signs that could cause fires (such as over-flowing rubbish bins), and a simulation of what to do if involved in helping at a car crash (photos on our Facebook group). This is the first meeting of an ongoing link between the Fire Service and groups such as Street Angels and Ambassadors. The Fire Service also offer a **FREE fire safety check** and free smoke alarms for every household in West Yorkshire - phone **0800 587 4536** to book your check (please pass this information around)
