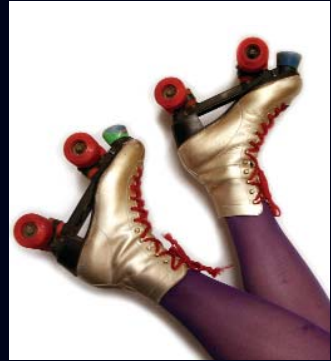


### RHYTHM AND RHYME FREE!

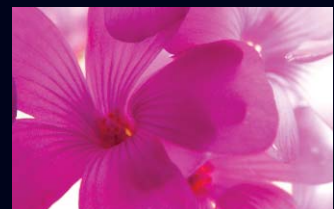

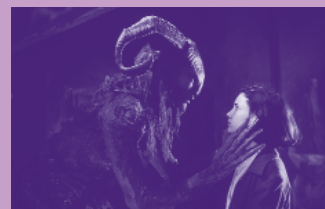
