

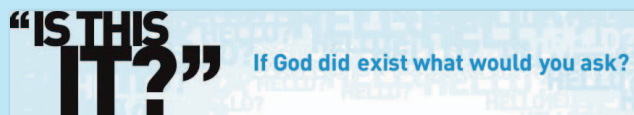
Children and Young People
