# X:site National Holiday

Cost: £120 which includes all meals and activities, but not travel to the holiday.

Age: For those in Key Stage 2 at Primary School (aged 8–11 years)

When: Mon 17 August–Fri 21 August 2009

How many on camp? 75 including leaders, with a ratio of about one leader for every three children.

We take all reasonable steps to ensure safety at X:site, though all activities carry some risk. Scripture Union is fully covered for public liability but we do advise everyone to take out cover against accident, cancellation, illness and loss of personal possessions which we do not cover. We can send you details of suitable insurance if you ask.

Children's details are kept on computer under Data Protection Act. We take photos to share with supporters, other organizations in sympathy with Scripture Union and children who attend the holiday. Children in photos will not be identified by full name. We cannot take responsibility for any photographs/video clips that are put onto social networking sites by guests on the holiday. Scripture Union may use photographs/video clips to promote its holidays on such sites.

X:site National Holiday is run by experienced adult team, including Scripture Union staff, but mostly volunteers, who receive training prior to the holiday. We have a Child Protection Policy and team members are subject to an Enhanced Disclosure from the Criminal Records Bureau.

In signing the Application Form, parents are agreeing to let their child come to camp and participate in all activities. Parents agree that their child will behave reasonably, or they may be asked to collect him or her, before the end of camp, without refund. If Scripture Union cancels the camp for any reason, your fees are safeguarded and will be refunded.
