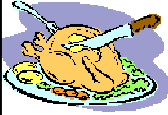

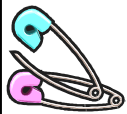

The next blood donor session will be on **Friday 24th September at St. John's**. There are other sessions in Brighthouse during July and August. Please check the local newspaper for information.



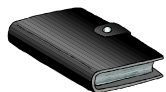
