The speaker on **Thursday 1st October** is South African Mike Rabbolini. Mike was raised as a Catholic, after leaving school he went into the surfing industry and proved successful at surfboard riding. Having neglected his faith, he found himself caught up in the drug culture that went with surfing in those days. In 1981 his life changed - Mike was healed from drugs and his failed marriage restored. Mike will share his life's journey - of near bankruptcy and financial ruin and of the Christian faith that gave him the strength to carry on...
