Villages Housing Community Budget Terms and Guidance

Introduction

The role of the Community Committee is to effectively use its resources by supporting and improving community activities for the residents of Stockbridge Village.

Grants are made to groups and individuals to provide equipment, help fund events and enable residents to participate in various activities representing Stockbridge Village or Fitton Hill.

Grants will not normally exceed £500.

Grants will be given on the following provisions:

- Grants must benefit the community of Stockbridge Village.
- Detail of the cost of individual items and quotes or estimates must be provided with the application form. An example may be 20 T shirts at £8 per item = £160, or Buffet for 30 at £6.50 per head = £195.
- Recipients of the Grant will be asked to provide evidence of how the grant was spent; this may be in the form of photographs and/or written or verbal feedback for use in the newsletter and other publications.
- Money received must be spent on the activity/equipment specified on the application form. Proof of purchase will be required.

Process

All Grant applications will be considered by the Stockbridge Village Estate Management Committee (SVEMC) or the Fitton Hill Estate Management Committee (FHEMC).

For dates of committee meetings please contact your local Community Development Officer.

Applications are required two weeks prior to the committee meeting. Please plan to have your application form submitted to the committee meeting prior to the event taking place.

In exceptional cases the committee will consider applications outside this timetable.
