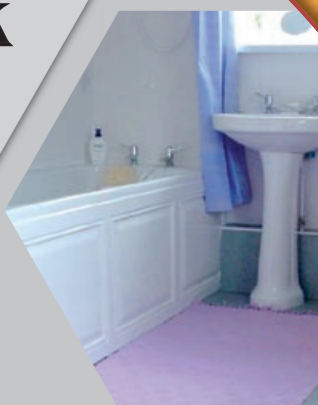

A1 Housing – an Easy Read guide to the decent homes standard

What is a decent home?

A decent home means somewhere that is in good condition. The government think everyone should live in a home that is in good condition.



They have made a plan about this called **the decent homes standard**.



The decent homes standard says that all council homes should be in good order. They should have a kitchen and a bathroom that are in good condition.



The decent homes standard and A1 Housing

A1 Housing is in charge of all the council homes in the area. It is our job to make sure that all council homes are in good condition.



If the kitchen and bathrooms are not up to the decent homes standard the government will give money to make the changes.



They will do this if:

- The bathroom is more than 30 years old and in a bad way
- The kitchen is more than 20 years old and in a bad way



What A1 are doing to make our homes decent?

The government have given us money to bring the homes we look after up to the standard.



If your home is already up to the standard then we will not be doing any work on it. We will only work on homes that need to be made up to the standard.
